1	Building utility systems	Building 4 of the Faculty of Business Administration has water supply, electricity, drainage, wastewater treatment, and building systems necessary for operation	Supports the continuous and safe use of learning spaces, workspaces, and various activities	Students/Academic Staff
2	Environmental and waste management	Solid waste from the various units is collected regularly, and the building's usage areas are maintained	Helps keep the environment clean, suitable for learning, and reduces sanitation problems	Students/Academic Staff
3	Building cleanliness and sanitation	The faculty employs housekeeping staff to maintain the cleanliness of classrooms, academic buildings, restrooms, and common areas every day	Keeps classrooms and common areas clean, ready for use, and conducive to the health of users	Students/Academic Staff
4	Fire protection system	A fire protection system is in place, with annual drills of the fire prevention, suppression, and evacuation plan	Helps prepare students and staff to respond correctly in emergencies	Students/Academic Staff
5	Security	The university provides security officers to the faculty to maintain order and report daily situations	Enhances the safety of life and property of students, staff, and visitors	Students/Academic Staff
6	Health and accident care	The faculty provides group accident insurance for all staff every year	Serves as a measure to mitigate risks and reduce the impact of potential accidents	Students/Academic Staff
7	Accessibility for persons with special needs	There are parking spaces for persons with disabilities, ramps for wheelchairs, and lifts for moving between floors	Enables persons with disabilities or physical limitations to more conveniently access the academic buildings and faculty services	Students/Academic Staff
